Major General Teodor INCICAS currently serves as Chief of the General Directorate for Armaments within Romanian Ministry of National Defence. In this capacity, Major General INCICAS is responsible to the Minister of Defence for the management of procurement strategies, policies and unfolding of the acquisition procedures and related contracts aimed at endowment of the armed forces with major weapons and equipment systems.

Further, his responsibilities include the coordination of the military research and development activities and participation of the specialized structures in R&D projects and programs at NATO and EU level as well as the supervision of quality management for military products.

Prior to this appointment, in the timeframe of 2017- 2020, Major General INCICAS served as Deputy for Resources of the Chief of Defence; also, previous appointments such as Intern Officer in the Logistics Directorate within the Security Investment, Logistics and Civil Emergency Planning Division/NATO HQ, Commander of the 121st Material Transport Battalion and Commander of the Logistic Support Base, Head of the Capability and International Organization Relationships Service within the Strategic Planning Directorate of General Staff, Head of the Internal Audit Directorate, Chief of Staff of Joint Logistics Command, all built a comprehensive military career along serving in the Ministry of National Defence.

Major General INCICAS graduated the Flag Officers and Ambassadors Course of NATO College in Rome, Multinational Joint Logistic Course of Oberammergau NATO School and NATO Logistics Course in Germany.
