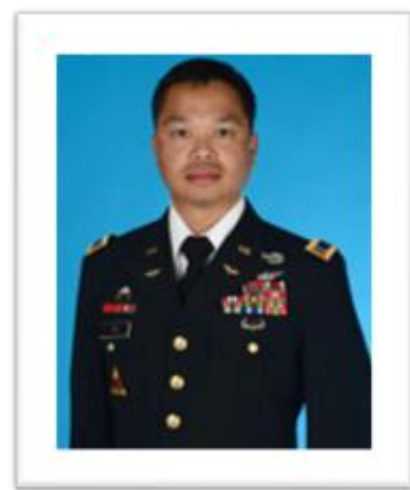


Chief Warrant Officer 5 Richard Q. Tiu
